Survival Finnish 2 ECTS

Schedule: Starts in September and October (twice a week in the evenings for about 1,5 months)

Content: Basic everyday situations in Finnish for complete beginners. Course language is English. Course is 24 hours all together and it consists of lectures, course works, oral and written exercises and exam. Course materials are provided at the course.

Introduction to Finnish Culture 3 (2) ECTS

Schedule: 9.00-12.00 (Mon 27.9., Mon 4.10., Mon 11.10., Fri 15.10. (Excursion), Mon 18.10.

Content: Introduction to Finnish Culture is a 3 credit course open for the international degree programme and exchange students at the LUAS. The aim is to show and discuss about basic cultural phenomena's: political and cultural history, communication, questions about identities and relations to the neighbouring countries. Student receives 2 credits by following the lessons and 1 credit by writing the given essay.

Cost: Excursion fee 15 euros



Finnish Cuisine 3 ECTS

Schedule: Thursdays 16.30 – 20.15 (4.11., 11.11., 18.11, 25.11., 2.12., 9.12., 16.12.)

Content: The students get a good picture about the basic Finnish cooking cuisine and daily diet. What do the Finns eat and how do they eat? What should you know about the Finnish food? What should you taste during your stay in Finland? How to tell about the Finnish cooking cuisine?

Cost: 20 euros for the raw material (food ingredients) for the whole course
